



iTheatrics Summer 2022 Internship

iTheatrics, a New York based musical theater education company is seeking summer interns to work as part of the 2022 iTheatrics Academy staff. The iTheatrics Academy creates and develops new musical adaptations of shows for young people in collaboration with clients such as Music Theatre International, Disney Theatricals, and Concord Theatricals.

Each summer the iTheatrics Academy workshops a new title each week with a group of approximately 40 young people grades 6-12. The workshop culminates in a staged reading for an audience of invited guests including the shows authors, educators, and family members.

Duties include: Leading daily warm-ups and/or focus activities, keeping accurate records of all script and score changes, supervision of students during lunch, checking students in and out each day, building or shopping for basic props, assisting with staging, choreography, or music direction when appropriate, and additional tasks associated with the program.

Dates: Internships begin on Friday, July 1st and end on Friday August 19th. Interns work from 8:30am – 5:30pm Monday – Friday and are free on the weekends. Interns must be able to commit to the entire summer.

Qualifications: Excellent candidates are high school graduates, proactive problem-solvers, have at least three years of theater experience (onstage or backstage in school, community, or professional settings), a strong desire to work with young people, and a true interest in musical theater. Additionally, candidates with experience in stage management and/or technical theater are a plus.

Payment: Interns receive a weekly stipend of \$500. Interns are responsible for their own housing in and transportation to and from the rehearsal studios in midtown Manhattan.
