Dates

Internships begin on Friday, June 20, 2025 and end on Wednesday, August 13, 2025. Interns work from 8:30am – 5:30pm Monday – Friday and are free on the weekends. Interns must be able to commit to the entirety of the summer dates.

Responsibilities

Leading daily warm-ups and/or focus activities, keeping accurate records of all script and score changes, supervision of students during lunch, checking students in and out each day, building or shopping for basic props, assisting with staging, choreography, or music direction when appropriate, and additional tasks associated with the program.





Qualifications

Excellent candidates are high school graduates, proactive problem-solvers, have at least three years of theater experience (onstage or backstage in school, community, or professional settings), a strong desire to work with young people, and a true interest in musical theater. Additionally, candidates with experience in stage management and/or technical theater are a plus.

Payment

Interns receive a weekly stipend of \$500. Interns are responsible for their own housing and transportation to and from the rehearsal studios in midtown Manhattan.
